Finished Quilt Size: 46.5" x 64.5"

## Fabric Requirements

Panel or Theme Fabric	2/3 yd
(If Directional Length of Fabric you need 1 1/4 yds.)	
1 <sup>st</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> Border	1/4 yd of <b>9</b> coordinating fabrics
2 <sup>nd</sup> Border	1/2 yd
Outer Border	1 1/8 yds
Binding	5/8 yd
Backing	3 yds
Batting	Twin Size

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# Peaceful Patchwork

Please Read and Follow Instructions Carefully to Ensure a Successful Project!

## Cutting Instructions:

- A. Panel or Theme Fabric (If directional Length of Fabric, center design in the Length):  
Centering Design, cut 22 1/2" x 40 1/2"
- B. 1st and 3rd Border:  
Cut (1) strip 2 1/2" x WOF\* from **each** of (9) fabrics (1st Border)  
Cut (1) strip 3 1/2" x WOF from **each** of (8) fabrics (3rd Border)
- C. 2nd Border:  
Cut (5) strips 2 1/2" x WOF
- D. Outer Border:  
Cut (6) strips 5 1/2" x WOF
- E. Binding:  
Cut (7) 2 1/2" strips x WOF

**\*WOF = Width of Fabric From Selvage to Selvage**

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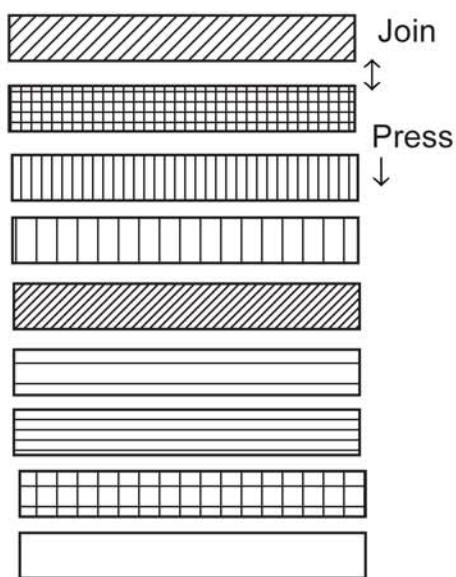
**Note:** All measurements are based on a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise noted.

## Piecing Instructions:

### 1st Border:

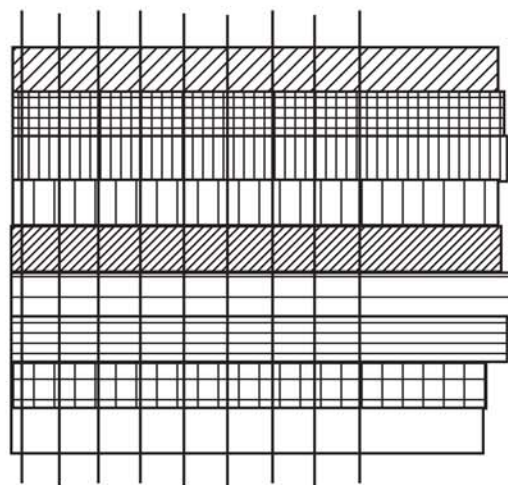
Using the (9) (B) 2 1/2" x WOF 1st Border strips, join into one strip set. See Diagram 1. Please note, a consistent seam allowance is necessary for the measurements to be accurate. Press seams down. Following Diagram 2, cut (8) 2 1/2" strips from your strip set.

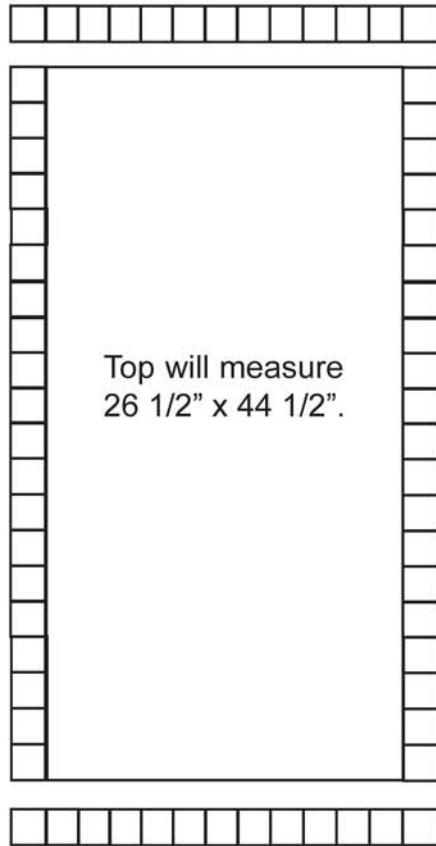


Cut (8) strips.

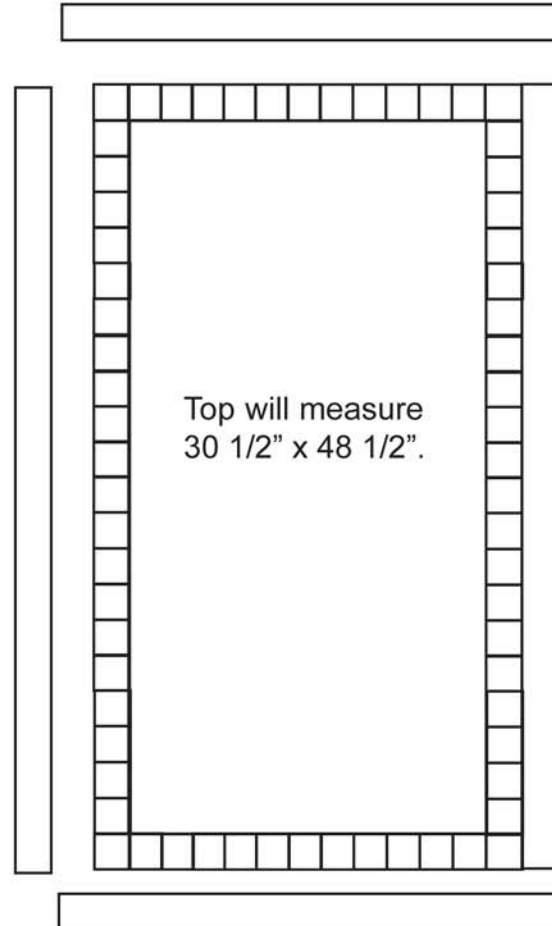
## **Piecing Continued:**

Using the (8) strips cut from the strip set made in Diagram 2, Pg. 1, join (2) strips plus (2) pieces taken from a third strip, creating a (20) piece Panel Border strip. Make (2). Join to sides of Panel or Theme Fabric. See Diagram 3. Press seams toward Panel or Theme Fabric. Next, using remaining (3) strips, join to create (2), (13) piece Panel Border strips. Join to top and bottom of Panel. Press seams toward Panel or Theme Fabric. Your top will now measure  $26 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $44 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

## **2nd Border:**

Join (C)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " 2nd Border strips to equal  $44 \frac{1}{2}$ ". Make (2). Attach to sides of 1st Pieced Border. Press seams toward 2nd Border. Next, cut remaining strips to equal  $30 \frac{1}{2}$ ". Make (2). Attach to top and bottom of 1st Pieced Border. Press seams toward 2nd Border. See Diagram 4. Top will measure  $30 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $48 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

## **3rd Border:**

Following Pg. 1, Diagrams 1 and 2, directions for 1st Border strips, join (8) B,  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " 3rd Border strips to create a strip set. From this strip set, cut (7)  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Join (2) strips to create a (16) piece 3rd Border set. Make (2). Attach to sides of quilt top. Press seams toward 2nd Border. Next, using remaining (3) strips, join to create (2), (12) piece strips. (You will need to join 2 strips and then remove excess pieces.) Attach to the top and bottom of quilt top. Press seams toward 2nd Border. Your top will now measure  $36 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $54 \frac{1}{2}$ ". See Diagram 5 on Pg. 3.



### **Outer Border:**

To determine the length of your outer side borders, measure quilt through the middle from top to bottom. Using (D) 5 1/2" Outer Border strips, join to equal this measurement. Make (2). Attach border strips to sides of quilt. Press seams toward outer border. Next, measure from side to side in the middle of your quilt to determine the length of your top and bottom outer borders. Using your remaining (D) 5 1/2" Outer Border strips, join to equal this measurement. Make (2). Attach to the top and bottom of quilt and press seams toward outer border. Your quilt should measure 46 1/2" x 64 1/2".

### **Quilting:**

Sandwich your quilt top with batting and backing. Baste layers together and quilt as desired to enhance design.

### **Binding:**

Join together binding strips and bind using your favorite method.

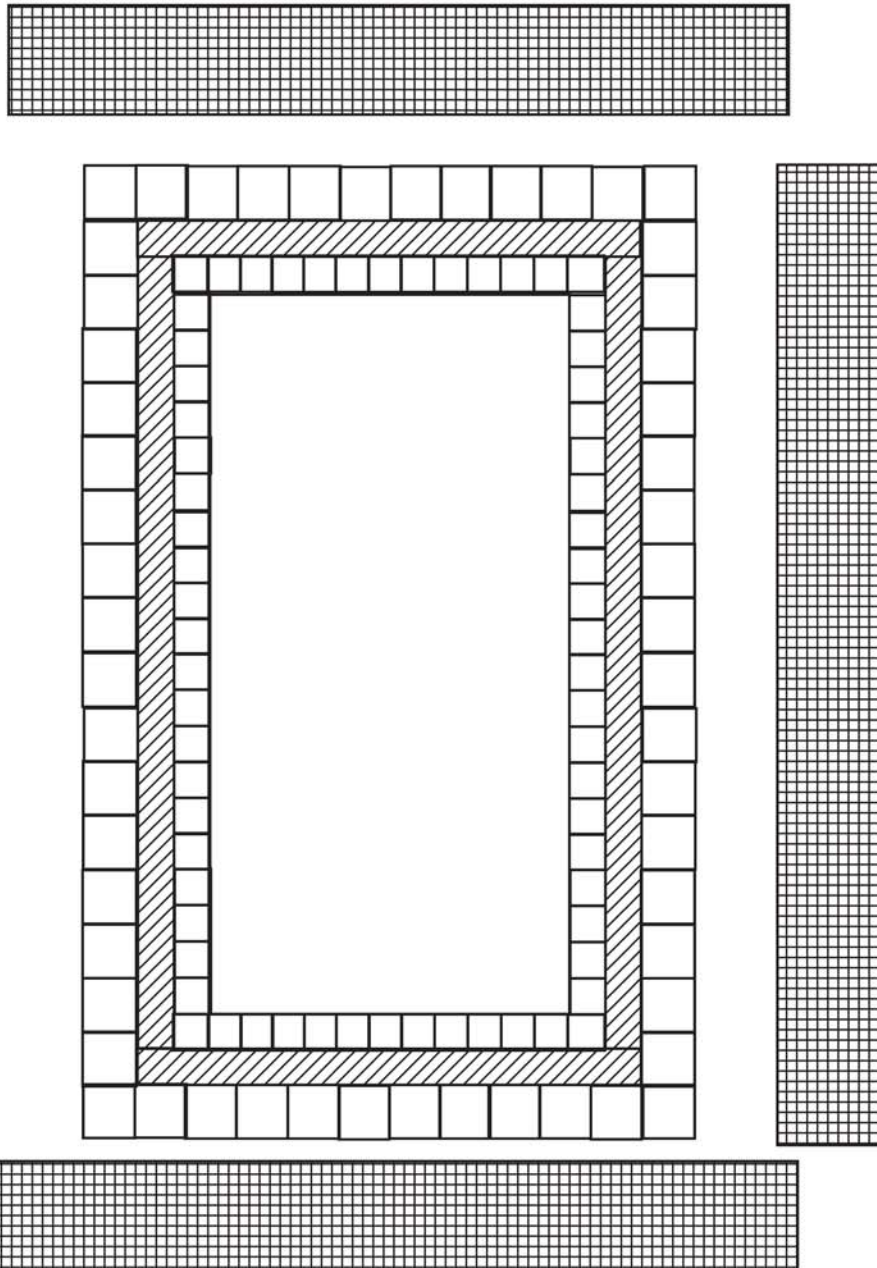
